MESSAGE FROM URGVS President, Yale Wishnick

Madison's 4-Step Strategy In my April membership message, I summarized why the national government has become so powerful. Before the ink on the US Constitution was dry, Alexander Hamilton manipulated our first President to expand the role and responsibilities of the federal government. Rulings to expand the power of the judiciary by America's first Chief Justice, John Marshall, contradicted almost everything advocated by the Founders during the ratification process of the Constitution. If you wonder why unelected bureaucrats control your life or why Congress seems oblivious to a 30 trillion dollar national debt, you have to look no farther than Hamilton and Marshall. **But there is hope**, and the possibility to restore our Republic exists if we choose to act.

A 4-Step Strategy James Madison gave to the American people to fight against the unconstitutional laws and regulations of the federal government. **1) Throw a Fit** - Madison felt the people would "throw a fit" when the federal government usurped their power. Americans would never tolerate the heavy hand of the national government. Madison believed Americans would rally, protest, and raise their voices in an organized fashion. **2) Collective Action** - Madison believed when enough people refused to comply, the government would not be able to enforce its unjust laws. Americans would join together and collectively act to protect their natural rights. **3) States' Rights** - With a public outrage, state governors and legislators would take formal action and protest on behalf of their state citizenry. State leaders would renounce the dictates of the federal unconstitutional laws and stand up for states' rights. **4) State Compacts** - Finally, states unite to form state compacts to ridicule and defy the federal government. Madison and Jefferson believed if several adjoining states unified and mobilized, it would be an effective tool to stop national unconstitutional acts.

The States are a Powerful Check Madison and Jefferson believed the above strategies would force the federal government to back down. Judge Andrew Napolitano (formerly of FOX news) said people need to stop enforcing unconstitutional federal laws. "If you could get an entire state doing this, federal laws would be impossible to implement." In this sense, the states are a powerful "check" on the national government's overreach.

So there you have it; **it's up to the American people**. More precisely, it's up to you and me to determine what we are prepared to do to protect our Faith, Family, and Freedom.
